The Bob Whyte Trophy – for athletic achievement

This award is made to a club member who has made a significant personal achievement during the year. Examples would be a notable improvement in racing performance, or attaining a personal goal.

Notable achievements in 2008:

- **Matt Clark** PBs in the Ashford 10k and Folkestone Half Marathon (by 6 mins); debut marathon of 3:26 at Amsterdam.
- **Terry Everest** PBs at 10k, 10 miles and half marathon, and the only club member to have competed in all 10 Kent Grand Prix events, scoring 774 pts for the club.
- **Nick Gibbins** Finisher in the 6 day 150 mile Marathon des Sables (244th place) in 38:44:30, and finisher in the London to Brighton trail race (56 miles) in 13:08.
- **Guy Gracey** PB at the Thanet 20m, and finisher in the Comrades Ultra Marathon (56m), South Africa in 10:42.
- **Roger Grist** PBs in the TW Half Marathon (by 2 mins), Paddock Wood Half Marathon (by 2 mins) and London Marathon.
